A vehicle traveling west on Morton Street blocked her travels at Norfolk Hardware because they needed to take a left on to Woodmere Street to enter the Boston Housing Authority Gallivan Development. Two streets Woodgate and Woodmere Streets both enter on to Morton Street exiting the development. Woodgate Street should be a two way street to allow traffic to enter and exit Morton Street before the traffic lights near the fire station to avoid any accidents.
